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## *Key Points of Interest*

### *Start: Novi Civic Center*

- Built in 1987.
- Serves as the City Hall and Community Center. Campus also hosts Police Department, Library, and Novi High School.



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### *1: Providence Hospital*

- A new, 200-bed hospital is scheduled to open in spring 2008.
- Represents a \$314 million investment in the community and the addition of 1,500 new jobs. Campus to include medical office buildings, a hotel and retail areas.



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## *Key Points of Interest*

### *2: Catholic Central High School*

- Founded by the Basilian Fathers in 1928, Catholic Central, a premiere college preparatory school, relocated to Novi and opened in August 2005.
- The 800+ member student body comes from more than 80 zip codes.



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### *3 & 4: Main Street Development/Andiamos*

- Considered to be the center of Novi, Main Street provides residential, office, retail, and entertainment in a downtown atmosphere.
- Andiamo Novi combines one of the nation's best Italian restaurants with two outstanding entertainment venues; The Second City-Detroit and the Dirty Martini Lounge.



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## *Key Points of Interest*

### *Twelve Oaks Mall*

- Construction began in February 2006 on Nordstrom, the mall's fifth department store, and will be complete in September 2007.
- In addition to Nordstrom, 25-30 new stores will be added.
- Macy's is expanding by 60,000 square-feet.



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### *Twelve Mile Crossing at Fountain Walk*

- Twelve Mile Road Crossing at Fountain Walk is a 737,000 square foot lifestyle, entertainment center with upscale retail, first class dining and unique entertainment in an open-air streetscape environment.
- The life style center is in the midst of redevelopment to make it the place in Novi where shopping, food and fun come together.



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## *Key Points of Interest*

### *5: Lakeshore Park*

- This 383-acre park hosts a number of events, including the Kid's Concert Series, Camp Lakeshore and mountain bike and running races.
- The Novi Mountain Bike Trail is more than 6.5 miles long.



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### *6: Erickson's Fox Run Retirement Village*

- Set within 108 acres of protected woodlands
- At build-out, will house 2,500 community members.



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## *Key Points of Interest*

### *Columbus Corporate Office Center*

- A \$25 million investment, the Columbus Corporate Office Center offers 130,000-square feet of office space



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### *7: Rock Financial Showplace*

- Largest, privately funded exposition center in Michigan.
- State of the art technology has been designed to accommodate all users, from large exhibitions to small business meetings.
