SUBJECT: Approval of purchase of necessary Motorola hardware for the implementation of the patrol car vehicular device workstations, removal of old workstations and installation of the new workstations in the amount of \$112,325. Federal Forfeiture Funds will be the funding source for this purpose.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The use of in-car laptops by the Novi Police Department Uniform Patrol Division has become an indispensable tool for the Patrol Officer. These devices are used seven days a week, 24 hours a day and are the most utilized computes in the City of Novi.

As part of our migration to the Oakland County Courts Law Enforcement Information System (CLEMIS), we are required to utilize the Motorola MW810 Device Workstation in all patrol vehicles. Motorola and Oakland County have signed a contractual agreement for the required vehicular device workstation. Due to this mandate, the Novi Police Department is requesting to purchase, through this agreement, (21) MW810 Mobile Workstations. This will include the associated three-piece vehicular terminal, mounting equipment, cables, modem, antennas, operating system, and a three year warranty (one year standard plus three years repair service advantage coverage). The costs associated with the removal of the existing vehicle devices and the installation of the new Motorola devices is also included in this proposal.

These workstations will replace the 19 laptops currently in service and provide two spares when repairs are needed.

The existing laptop units were purchased in 2002 and are beyond the end of their useful life. In addition, all warranties are expired. Maintenance costs are increasing substantially as devices become unusable due to serviceability issues. The current units will not support the software necessary for the CLEMIS migration.

The replacement will be completed through a partnership between the Police Information System/Records Manager, Fleet Maintenance and the City's Information Technology staff. A phased in approach to the replacement process will be applied as to not disrupt vehicle availability.
