Day 1: Arrival at Rock Island, Illinois Welcome to the Quad Cities! Begin your adventure by checking into Bally's Casino, where you'll spend the next three nights. Enjoy luxury accommodations with a 50" TV, walk-in shower, and scenic views. Dinner is at the Player's Buffet, featuring live-action carving stations, fried chicken, stir fry, Italian cuisine, and more. D

Day 2: Rock Island Arsenal and Botanical Gardens. Start with breakfast at the Player's Buffet followed by a tour of the Rock Island Arsenal and Museum. Other historical sites include the Colonel Davenport House and Rock Island National Cemetery. Next, tour the Butterworth Center & Deere-Wiman Homes, renowned for their rich history and Venetian Art Ceiling. Enjoy lunch on your own, followed by a visit to the Quad Cities Botanical Garden to experience the lush gardens and interactive exhibits. In the evening, embark on a Captain's Dinner Cruise aboard the Celebration Belle, savoring prime rib and live entertainment while cruising the Mississippi River. BD

Day 3: Artistic Delights and Theatrical Thrills. After breakfast, head to the Isabel Bloom Sculpture Studio to learn about handcrafted cement sculptures depicting children, animals, and family motifs. Then, enjoy a unique experience at Circa '21 Dinner Playhouse with a meal served by The Bootleggers, followed by a vibrant live theater performance of "Chicago". "**Chicago**" is a 1975 American musical with music by John Kander, lyrics by Fred Ebb, and book by Ebb and Bob Fosse. Set in Chicago in the jazz age, the musical is based on a 1926 play of the same title by reporter Maurine Dallas Watkins, about actual criminals and crimes on which she reported. The story is a satire on corruption in the administration of criminal justice and the concept of the "celebrity criminal". Dinner is included tonight. BLD

Day 4: Journey to Dubuque, Iowa. Enjoy breakfast before departing for Dubuque, Iowa. Visit the iconic Field of Dreams Movie Site in Dyersville, where you can step onto the famous baseball field. We will arrive in Dubuque for lunch on our own and explore the city. In the afternoon, we will visit the National Mississippi River Museum & Aquarium, featuring interactive exhibits about the Mississippi River's history and ecology. Stay overnight in Dubuque at the elegant Hotel Julian Dubuque, with a private dinner in its historic setting. BD
