Ken forwarded me your inquiry about a sidewalk on Quince Dr. It's been discussed briefly at recent Mobility Committee meetings. We will be working on sidewalk gap prioritization with the committee this year. Our next meeting is scheduled for March 19th, 6-7pm in the Council Conference Room at the Civic Center. We can look at adding the segment on the west side of Quince from 10 Mile to Tamara to a future sidewalk gap infill project. In the past, we've gotten negative feedback from residents in the neighborhood concerning sidewalk along their frontage, so hopefully the 4 homeowners on the west side of Quince that would be affected will not be opposed to it.
