BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Novi Police and Fire Benevolent Association is a non-profit organization, based in Novi, Michigan. They are applying for a Charitable Gaming License from the State of Michigan and are Required by the State Act 382 of 1972 to request a resolution recognizing them as a non-profit organization from the jurisdiction where they are based. Such a resolution carries no obligation from or endorsement by the City of Novi. This resolution will allow the NPFBA to qualify for the charitable gaming license to hold permitted charitable gaming activities such as a 50/50 raffle during the charity hockey game, the annual golf outing, and other qualifying events throughout the year.


The Police Department has reviewed their submission and finds no reason to deny the request.
