Attached please find applications for the current openings on Boards and Commissions along with a ratings sheet and current Boards & Commissions Booklet List. The format for Boards & Commissions appointments has been modified due to recent changes in Council Rules. A relatively brief application followed by interviews in which Council had the opportunity to ask candidates questions has been replaced with a more comprehensive application along with a two minute introduction to Council. Because these changes occurred after applications had already been received, an addendum containing the new questions was sent to candidates. Those responses are included in this packet. Revised applications will be used going forward.
