### **REMARKS FROM THE CHAIRPERSON**

Chairperson Thomas noted that \$75k was approved in the budget for the creation of a Broadband Master Plan. The Council would ultimately have to approve the project.

## MATTERS FOR COMMITTEE DISCUSSION

- 1. Broadband Master Plan
  - Key discussions included the need for fiber to every home and business, reducing installation costs, and incentivizing ISPs.
  - They emphasized the importance of future-proofing the plan and ensuring it meets the community's needs.
  - Councilmember Heintz questions the relationship between small cell towers and broadband, including 5G.
  - Chairperson Thomas emphasizes the importance of having a goal-oriented plan that ensures every home and business has access to fiber.
  - Chairperson Thomas suggests exploring different approaches, including municipal broadband and the Farmington model.
  - The group discusses the potential benefits and challenges of each approach, including the need for a professional consultant to provide a comprehensive plan.
  - Councilmember Heintz emphasizes the importance of reducing costs and making it easier for companies to install fiber.
  - The discussion includes the need for a multi-pronged approach that addresses both need-based and market-driven solutions.

- 2. Broadband Service Survey
  - Chairperson Thomas suggests surveying to gather public feedback on broadband needs and satisfaction.
  - The group agrees to review the survey's questions and ensure they address key points such as knowledge, needs, cost, and satisfaction.
  - The group discusses specific survey questions, including the importance of high-speed fiber internet for the community's economic future.
  - Councilmember Heintz suggests focusing on questions that address knowledge, needs, cost, and satisfaction.

#### **ROUNDTABLE DISCUSSION**

- Chairperson Thomas and Councilmember Smith agree to work on the flash survey questions and gather community input.
- The next committee meeting is scheduled for July 23rd.
